

Futures Summer Camp 2022

The Futures Summer Camp offers 16 individual camps designed to spark students' interest in a vast variety of career-threaded pathways, the fine arts, the sciences, and sports-related activities.

The Futures Summer Camp program is offered to students entering grades 7, 8, and 9, and is free of charge for students through the Perkins Grant, GEAR UP New Hampshire Grant, and district funds. Registration is now open to out-of-district students. Class sizes range from 10 to 20 participants, so space is limited.

We will offer a bag lunch, provided by the Spartan Summer Lunch Program, to all campers, free of charge. We have arranged for bus transportation from Shaw's in Lancaster at 7:20 am and from the Whitefield Common at 7:40 am, sharp. Bus drop-off will be at the Whitefield Common at 12:10 pm and Shaw's at 12:30 pm. Parents/guardians are welcome to drop off students at WMRHS by 8:00 am and pick them up by 12:00 pm if preferred.

2022 Futures Camp Offerings:

Spartan Soccer Camp is designed for players of all levels who want to learn and improve their fundamental soccer skills in a fun and encouraging environment. Players are given the unique opportunity to receive individual instruction from WMRHS high school coaching staff. Each day is filled with a variety of activities to promote correct soccer techniques including footwork, passing, trapping, and shooting. Campers will also learn team concepts; technical and ball skill work, and mini team games.

Wilderness Camp offers campers the opportunity to develop skills through active participation in a session where they will mountain bike, hike, and explore the natural beauty of the surrounding White Mountains. Campers will have the unique opportunity to work with WMRHS staff to develop teamwork, real-life wilderness skills, and a genuine appreciation for the natural world!

Outdoor Adventure Camp gives campers an opportunity to explore a variety of sports that can benefit them for life! Campers will learn the fundamentals of sports such as archery, golf, badminton, biking, pickleball, volleyball, and more.

Spanish Camp... come and join Profe Macakova as she introduces you to the Spanish language and culture! Students will be encouraged to learn basic vocabulary and practice phrases to start a conversation as well as learn about Hispanic culture through music, dance, geography, and more. Don't miss out on this great opportunity!

Leadership Camp... Participants will enjoy four days of exposure to elements of the Army JROTC program. Focus is on land navigation, marksmanship, physical training, and team building. Participating youth should be willing to try new things and push their boundaries. Participants should expect to spend each four-hour block outdoors. In the event you think you might be interested in a future career that requires leadership and outdoor skills, or simply want to do something a little different then this is the opportunity for you. All participants must exhibit a high level of maturity and be ready for outdoor physical activity and adventure.

Culinary Camp (SESSION FULL!) combines the art of food with hands-on experience in food preparation. Under the direction of Chef Matthew Holland, Culinary Camp is designed for students who love to cook, regardless of skill level. Each student will learn the basics of kitchen safety while developing the skills to create culinary masterpieces.

Criminal Investigation Camp is a camp for those who have an interest in being in law enforcement. If you want to learn from our local law enforcement personnel and are curious about scenario response, radio communications, fingerprinting, search and rescue, and the law enforcement tool belt, then this camp is for you!

Welding Camp...under the direction of Dana Graham, come learn to fuse, cut, bend, and shape metal in this welding camp. This program will focus on MIG welding techniques, Stick welding techniques, and plasma torch cutting.

Short Film Making...calling all actresses, actors, and camera operators! Film Production summer camp is for any students who really enjoy being creative in front of or behind the camera. Join us to learn how to create stories, write scripts, storyboard, film, and edit to make your own short films. Campers will leave camp with a finished short film to share with friends and family. No prior film, video editing, or acting experience necessary. The class will be taught by WMRHS art teacher Marc Salmin.

WMSI Robotics Camp, taught by White Mountain Science, Inc. will give students the opportunity to learn about robotics and coding with a hands-on, project-based approach where students will learn to think like engineers, test and tweak designs, debug and optimize, develop computational thinking skills, calibrate, and more. Student fun will be centered around LEGO SPIKE Prime Robotics kits. Space is limited, so please sign up early.

Tennis Camp...whether you are picking up a racquet for the first time, or would like to play competitively in high school, Tennis Camp offers just the right program to help you serve, volley, and score your way to find a lifetime sport to enjoy! This camp will take place at the Colonel Town courts from 8:00 am to 11:30 am.

Music Camp- This camp offers beginning and intermediate musicians the opportunity to explore various aspects of music in a fun and supportive environment. Students will practice an instrument, create their own music using online composition programs, and learn more about music theory and musicians through a variety of games. Students will leave camp with a new instrument to keep and practice on their own at home!

Spartan Field Hockey summer camp is aimed at teaching kids about the strategies of field hockey, including the rules and regulations, as well as the fundamentals on both the offensive and defensive sides of the ball. We'll teach you the correct strategies and skills to get you prepared for middle school and high school levels of play. If you don't have any equipment, we'll provide it for you!

Let's Get Crafty...this summer camp is a fun opportunity for any student who likes to make things and enjoys being creative. During the week, students will create a variety of craft projects. No prior art instruction or skills are necessary.

Health Explorers...are you a middle school student interested in connecting with other students this summer to explore different health careers? During this adventure week, you will participate in many hands-on activities like simulation lab activities, dissections, making your own toothpaste, oral and public health emergency preparedness fun, and much more!

Spartan Basketball Camp is aimed at teaching kids the fundamentals of basketball, including rules and strategies, as well as individual offensive and defensive skills. Campers will participate in contests, drills, and

mini-games. The goal of this camp is to prepare each camper for the upcoming season in a positive coaching environment. Come try our Shoot Away machine and become a better shooter!
