- Thanks expressed to Mike Claflin, Jeff Woodburn, and Commissioner Meyers for their support in this process
- Changes from initial pro forma presented: Revised Reimbursement Rates and *new* Room & Board rate for both state and Medicaid reimbursement
- Pro forma included NCHC assumptions that were not included in original pro forma
- Accreditation and Program Consultants incorporated into budget
- Letter from Commissioner Meyers supporting venture with up to \$250,000

## **Comments:**

- Consider Sweep account to maximize financial gain
- Begin accreditation process at earliest possible time.
- State extended Friendship House contract to end of September 2017
- Consider Exit Strategy to examine future use of building
- Two-year rate commitment from state
- Consortium not party in Purchase and Sale Agreement, only AHEAD
- AHEAD absorbs exposure and obligated to serve low and very low income clients
- Friendship House remains non-profit
- Creative guidance and innovation remains key role for Consortium
- Develop steps to manage waiting list and integrate recovery continuum throughout community
- Consider strategy to address YR 0 deficit
- Friendship House license expires in October 2018
- Community Services block grant not included in revenue
- Consider consultant from YR 0 through YR 5
