Motion to approve the North Country Health Consortium's Agreement with Tri-County Community Action Program for provision of services for the 1115 Waiver DSRIP IDN Region 7. The Agreement provides for the provision of services in an amount not to exceed \$100,904.00 for Fiscal Year 2018.

Motion to approve the North Country Health Consortium's Agreement with Ammonoosuc Community Health Services (ACHS) for provision of services for the 1115 Waiver DSRIP IDN Region 7. The Agreement provides for the provision of services in an amount not to exceed \$98,638.36 for Fiscal Year 2018.

### <u>New Grant Opportunity – Rural Health Care Services Outreach Program:</u>

Nancy announced that she submitted a \$20,000 grant from **Endowment for Health Opportunity** to help cover a consultant for CARF accreditation for the Friendship House.

Nancy asked the Board for permission to move forward in applying for the **SAMHSA SBIRT FOA.** This is a 5-year grant.

Nancy Bishop made the motion to move forward with the grant at Nancy's discretion. Kristina Fjeld-Sparks seconded the motion. Motion passed unanimously

Nancy then spoke about the **Tillotson Fund.** She has been encouraged to apply to this fund to help with operating expenses.
