


Daily Decision Support Briefing

Max Wind Gusts Tonight/Thursday



What To Expect

Dry weather will continue into early next week with a low chance of a light shower Sat. night or Sunday.

Flooding: Areas rivers have crested and will continue to recede. However, minor river flooding on the Androscoggin and Kennebec continue (moderate near Hallowell) into tonight and early Thursday.

Flood Warnings | River Forecasts

<u>Wind</u>: Northwest winds increase tonight and peak Thursday with gusts of 25 to 35 MPH, potentially resulting in additional isolated power outages or hindering restoration efforts. The strongest winds are expected in the mountains and central ME.

<u>Temperatures</u>: Cooler with much of the day spent below freezing Thurs/Fri. Widespread lows in the single digits to teens expected <u>Thursday night and Friday night. Warm-up over the weekend.</u>
