Overview of OUD in the 603: *OUD in the 603* is a training designed to prepare EMS, Fire, and Law Enforcement to understand opioid use disorder and to learn more about their potential role in reducing the impact of the disorder. This training will also provide a 'Vicarious Stress' segment to reduce compassion fatigue.

Training goals include:

- Recognizing opioids as a statewide issue
- Reduce negative impact on providers through vicarious stress
- Understanding opioid use disorder as a disease, not a choice
- Beyond administering Naloxone, and in collaboration with the North Country Health Consortium's Wellness and Recovery Model program, provide assistance in accessing treatment
