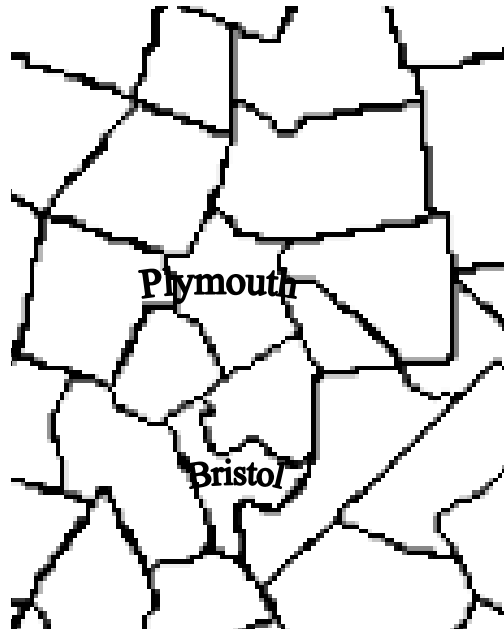




Mid-State Health Center

The Molar Express



The Molar Express is a program of the North Country Health Consortium. They are New Hampshire's only mobile dental clinic. The Molar express visits schools, nursing homes and holds community clinics in several locations throughout the North Country. Their mission: "to provide oral health services to all ages. We believe that by providing access, preventative dental services and education on good oral care, we can improve the health of people in Coos and Grafton counties." The Molar Express truck can provide services typically found in any general dental practice including: diagnostic and preventative care (screenings, digital x-rays, cleaning, sealant applications, fluoride treatments and oral examinations), treatment (fillings and extractions) and minor oral surgery.
